HONOURARY MEMBERSHIP

In recognition of an individual's contribution to funeral service in British Columbia, the Funeral Service Association of B.C. may bestow upon his/her retirement a Honourary Membership.

1. Criteria

Honourary Membership is granted to an individual in accordance to the following criteria.

- a) The recipient has been a member in good standing of the Association for at least ten (10) years.
- b) The recipient has helped the advancement of the Association.

2. Procedure

- a) Association members can submit the name(s) of a member(s) for Honourary Membership by sending a Letter of Recommendation to the Membership Committee;
- b) The letter will include a brief biography of the individual(s) and contain at least two (2) letters of sponsorship signed by members in good standing of the Association;
- c) The Membership Committee will review the submission(s) and make its recommendation to the Board of Directors.
- d) Upon approval of the Board of Directors, the FSABC shall invite the recipient(s) to the next Annual Conference and defray cost of the banquet meal for the recipient(s) and guest at the banquet;
- e) The Honourary Membership award will be presented to the recipient(s) at the Association's Annual Conference. If the recipient(s) is unable to attend the Annual Conference, the award shall be sent to the individual(s).
