Have the Conversation

Don't shy away from the tough conversations. Talk to your family, ask questions, and record your details so your wishes are understood and fully respected.



Pre-Arrange Services

Meet with your local BCFA Member Funeral Provider to record your wishes, preplan services, and discuss prepayment options.



Choose an Executor

Creating a Will and choosing an Executor reduces burden on your family and ensures that your wishes are followed.

Step 1: Have the Conversation. When a resident enters care, discuss what plans they may have in place, who needs to be involved, and what matters to them.

Step 2: Preplan Services. Preplanning involves choosing a funeral provider, discussing options, and recording wishes. Having plans in place brings peace of mind and clarity.

Step 3: Prepay Services. Prepayment saves money and burden when a death occurs. Prepayment happens in today's dollars and ensures that wishes can be followed.

Step 4: Create a Will and Choose an Executor. Funeral and disposition wishes written in the Will must be followed. The Executor will be the ultimate decision maker.

Step 5: Have a Plan. Funeral Providers must follow particular protocols before initiating services. Make sure you have a communication plan when a death occurs.
